Child Sexual Exploitation

The Government has released new guidance for schools. All staff who have regular contact with children should be aware of latest guidance, which can be found [here](#). Please take time to read at least Section A. The guidance covers:

- What is child sexual exploitation?
- Potential indicators of child sexual exploitation
- How are children sexually exploited?
- How does child sexual exploitation affect children?
- How to respond: working with young people.
- What does the particular nature of exploitation mean for practice?

If you are concerned a child might be subject to CSE, you must follow normal Safeguarding Procedures.
