Paragraph lengths varied and used to achieve deliberate effects.

Interesting to read - no boring details!
Precise language: verbs, adjectives and adverbs.
Figurative language: similes, metaphors, personification.
Reference to all the human senses, not just sight.
Dramatic devices: repetition, exaggeration.
Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPaG)
Simple sentences.
Compound sentences.
Complex sentences.
Semi-colons.
Varied sentence length, focus and pace.
Punctuation used to achieve deliberate effects.
Bracketing commas to mark off dependent clauses in complex sentences.
Punctuation of direct speech.
